To the Hon. The Post Master General

The Memorial of the Municipal Council of the United Township of Stanhope and Sherborne respectfully sheweth that the establishment of a Post office at Browns Corners on the Peterson Road and on lot number seventeen in the first concession of the Township of Stanhope would be a great accommodation to a large number of settlers both in the Township of Stanhope and Minden – that there is yet a large tract of very good land both in Stanhope and Minden yet to settle which is likely to settle soon.
