Sir,

In compliance with instructions contained in your letter No 134 of the 29<sup>th</sup> April last the office at "Jones' Falls" in the County of South Leeds was put into operation on the first June last.

Jones Falls is supplied specially from Morton with a semi weekly mail, length of route three miles. For the performance of the mail service I have, subject to your approval, made a two years agreement with the Postmaster Mr. Thomas Kinney, at the rate of \$40 per annum.

I have also, in compliance with instructions contained in your letter No. 151 of the 31<sup>st</sup> My last opened two new offices therein authorized, viz. – "Boskung" in the Township of Stanhope, and "Peterson's Corners" (reopened) in the Township of Hindon, both in the Provisional County of Haliburton. For the supply of these offices a weekly mail service has been established between Boskung and Minden – length of route fourteen miles and for the performance of the service I have, subject to your approval, made an agreement for two years with Mr. Joseph Beatty, Postmaster at Boskung, at the rate of \$65 per annum.
